



## 21 STONEY CREEK & BRUNETTE RIVER

**BURNABY • COQUITLAM** *Hardpacked trails* **13km one way • 26km return**

Ride along two waterways in East Burnaby — Stoney Creek and the Brunette River. You'll see salmon habitat, a community garden, a dam...and maybe a *DRAGON!* Combining transit and trails, the route starts at Burquitlam Station and ends at Braid Station, or park near Stoney Creek Trailhead for a 26km out-and-back ride.

N Clarke, L Como Lake, R Elmwood, L Gardena,  
L trail beside #643, R Claremont, L Jefferson, R North Rd

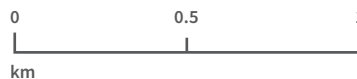
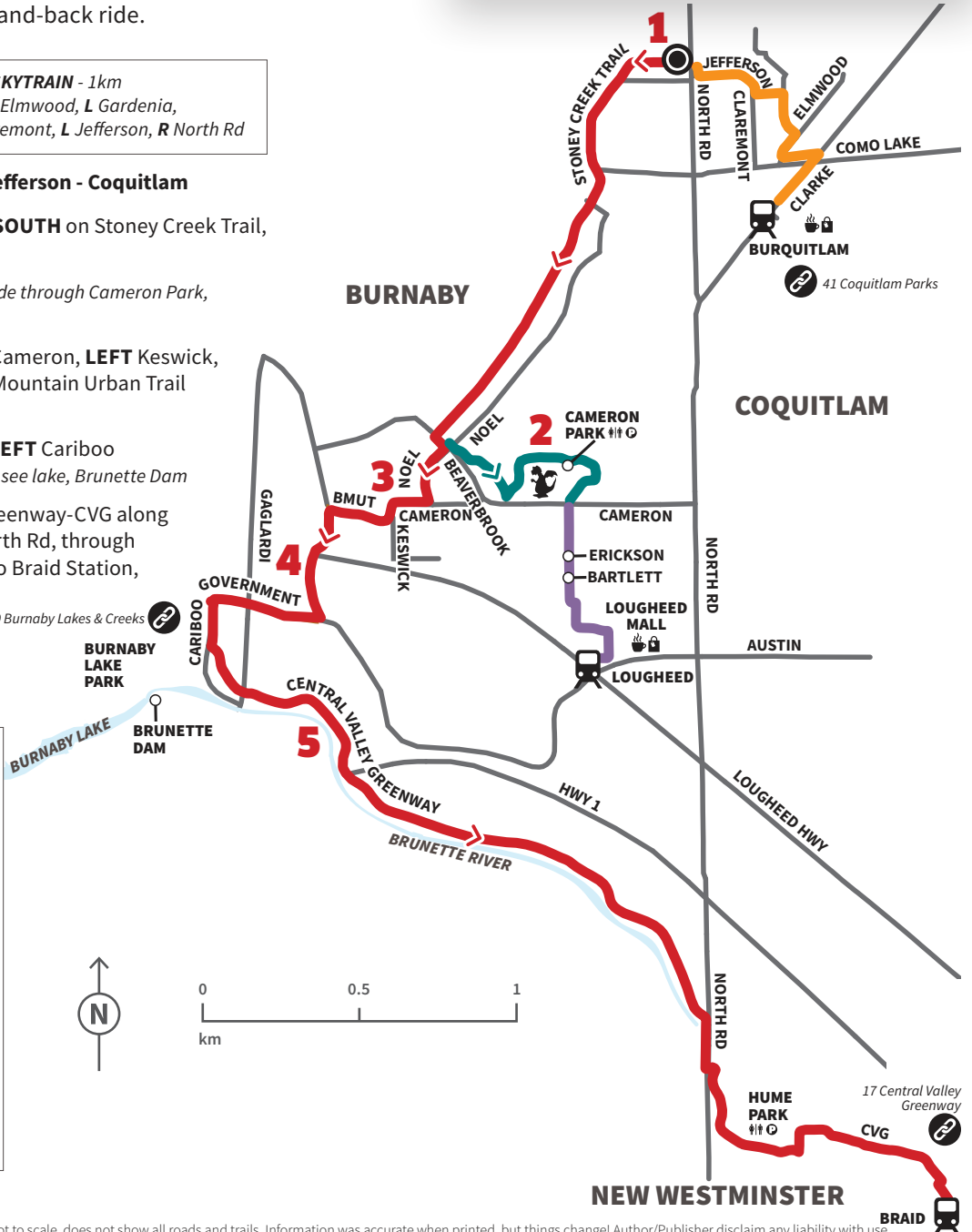
**START - at North Rd & Jefferson - Coquitlam**

- 1** Just north of Jefferson, **SOUTH** on Stoney Creek Trail, **LEFT/E** Beaverbrook
- 2** \**CAMERON the DRAGON*: ride through Cameron Park, visit dragon at SW corner
- 3** **SOUTH** Noel, **RIGHT/W** Cameron, **LEFT** Keswick, **RIGHT** BMUT - Burnaby Mountain Urban Trail - stay left at trail fork
- 4** **RIGHT/W** Government, **LEFT** Cariboo  
\*enter Burnaby Lake Park to see lake, Brunette Dam
- 5** **LEFT/E** Central Valley Greenway-CVG along Brunette River, cross North Rd, through Hume Park, follow CVG to Braid Station, or return via same route
