

BELCARRA & SASAMAT LAKE 40

PORT MOODY • **BELCARRA** Paved and hardpacked trails, shared roads 26km route

CAMP

How about a ride out to my neck of the woods – Belcarra Park? It offers a variety of terrain: trails, shared roads, challenging hills, and a bit of singletrack. Visit Sasamat Lake, see views of Indian Arm, and explore Belcarra Park's forested trails.

START at Moody Centre Skytrain - Port Moody

- **1** WEST Spring, **RIGHT/N** Moody overpass into Rocky Point Park, EAST on Shoreline Trail, follow signs
- 2 At Old Orchard Park continue WEST on Alderside
- 3 At April Rd go LEFT/W loco A busy road no bike lane 1km, **RIGHT/N** First Ave *explore old loco Townsite
- LEFT Bedwell Bay Rd

- **5 RIGHT** into White Pine Beach, at Sasamat Lake choose: a) TRAIL: just north of concession enter Bowzer Dog Walk Trail - rough sections, RIGHT at Sasamat Camp, LEFT Senkler b) ROAD: retrace on White Pine Rd, RIGHT/W Bedwell Bay Rd
- 6 WEST Bedwell, RIGHT Kelly, *go RIGHT on Marine for Indian Arm fiord view
- 7 WEST Marine, LEFT West Rd *or take park trail, **RIGHT/W** Bedwell
- 8 **LEFT** Midden to Belcarra Park *Explore Belcarra Village: N Belcarra Bay Rd, W Turtlehead, retrace to park
- 9 Behind park concession EAST on Springboard Trail, up to Woodhaven Swamp, just past swamp go LEFT over crosswalk, **RIGHT/E** on first trail
- **10** Emerge on road, continue **EAST** to Bedwell, retrace route back to Port Moody: **R** First, **L** loco, **R** Alderside, Shoreline Trail



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
