



64 WHITE ROCK & SOUTH SURREY LOOP

SURREY • WHITE ROCK *Hardpacked trails and quiet country roads* 32km loop



Explore historic trails of South Surrey and beaches of White Rock on this loop. Ride the Semiahmoo Trail along the Nicomekl River, visit Crescent Beach and Blackie Spit, then ride past the beaches of White Rock — a great ride!

📍 START - at Marine Drive & Kent St - White Rock

- 1** N Kent, **RIGHT/E** Roper, cross 160-Stayte, **LEFT/N** first lane, quick **RIGHT** 14-Thrift, **LEFT/N** 160a, **LEFT/W** 16-NBluff, **RIGHT/N** 160
- 2** **LEFT** Alder, **RIGHT** on first trail through Alderwood Park, emerge **W** on 18th *or take park: **R** Flower, **L** 19th, **L** park trail
- 3** **WEST** on 18th, **RIGHT** Southmere, past 19th
***SOUTHMERE LAKES: SOUTH** to loop lakes, return **NORTH** on Southmere Village trail, cross 20 Ave
- 4** **LEFT/N** 151a to Semiahmoo Trailhead, ride Semiahmoo Trail - 5km
- 5** **RIGHT** 144, quick **LEFT** Crescent, **RIGHT/N** Elgin, **LEFT/W** Nicomekl River trail to Elgin Park, *explore trails, **WEST** on river trail
- 6** **RIGHT/W** Crescent - road section ⚠️
- 7** **CRESCENT BEACH:** After railway tracks, first **RIGHT** Maple trail, *explore Blackie Spit trails, emerge at pier, take Crescent Beach Trail to south end, **LEFT** Maple, **RIGHT/E** Beecher then Crescent *Sunflower Cafe
- 8** **RIGHT** Tullock, **RIGHT** 126, **RIGHT** 27, **RIGHT/N** 124b, **LEFT** Crescent then Seacrest
- 9** **RIGHT/S** 124-Ocean Park
- 10** Enter Kwomais Park trail at 14th, leave park **EAST** on Marine through White Rock, back to start
