



## 72 LADNER LOOP-DE-DOOP

**DELTA** Varied dyke trails and roadways **38km loop**

Ladner is a cyclist's dream ... flat ... scenic ... and fun! Visit the quaint town of Ladner, then explore many trails — Brunswick Point, Great Blue Heron Way, through Tsawwassen and Beach Grove then onto Boundary Bay Trail. Return via 64th street back — *what a loop!*

📍 **START at Deas Island Park - Delta**

- 1** WEST Millennium Trail, RIGHT/N through underpass
- 2** WEST past marina, LEFT/S Ferry, RIGHT/W River
- 3** LEFT/S Elliot, RIGHT/W Bridge, RIGHT/N Delta \*explore Ladner Town Center
- 4** LEFT/W Chisholm, LEFT Georgia, RIGHT/W 48, LEFT 47a, RIGHT/W River Rd - some road sections
- 5** \*Visit Wellington Point Park, WEST on River Rd \*Westham Island Bridge, shared road
- 6** \*BRUNSWICK POINT TRAIL • 5km one way, 10km return:  
Out and back trail - ⚠️ does not connect
- 7** LEFT/S 34, LEFT 33A, RIGHT/S 41B, RIGHT/W 27B to second Tsawwassen First Nations sign, SOUTH on trail - Great Blue Heron Way
- 8** LEFT on boardwalk, EAST Blue Heron, LEFT/N Salish Sea, RIGHT Canoe Pass, RIGHT/S 52nd, enter bike path R Spyglass, Silverado, Candlewyck, R 18th
- 9** EAST on 17A, through South Delta Rec Centre parking lot, to shoreline, LEFT Boundary Bay Trail - shared with farm vehicles
- 10** LEFT/N 64, cross Ladner Trunk, Hwy 99 underpass
- 11** LEFT 60-Vasey, at River Rd RIGHT/E on Millennium trail back to Deas Island Park
