
BURNABY • VANCOUVER Paved and hardpacked trails, bikeway or shared quiet roads 6km one way • 12km return


Explore Burnaby's Fraser Foreshore Park and Vancouver's River District Trail on this section of the Canyon to Coast Trail. Ride the Fraser River shoreline and look for tugboats, barges, and log booms. There are places to stop and view the river, eat at Romer's Burger Bar at the foot of Kerr Street, or you can bring a picnic lunch and watch the river traffic go by.



START at Burnaby Foreshore Park south end of Byrne Road - Burnaby

- **1** WEST on bike path *explore park trails
- 2 At Boundary Rd continue **WEST** on River District Trail
- **3** WEST through Riverfront and Gladstone Parks, keep LEFT/W on riverside path
- At Argyle, return via same route or via cue 5
- **EAST** Kent Bikeway, at Boundary **RIGHT** North Fraser Way, 5 **RIGHT** Glenlyon Urban Trail, **RIGHT** into Foreshore Park
- *TERMINUS PARK TRAILS 3km: from Burnaby Foreshore Park: 6 EAST Fraser Park Dr, enter Terminus Park, explore trails
