



13 VANCOUVER TO STEVESTON

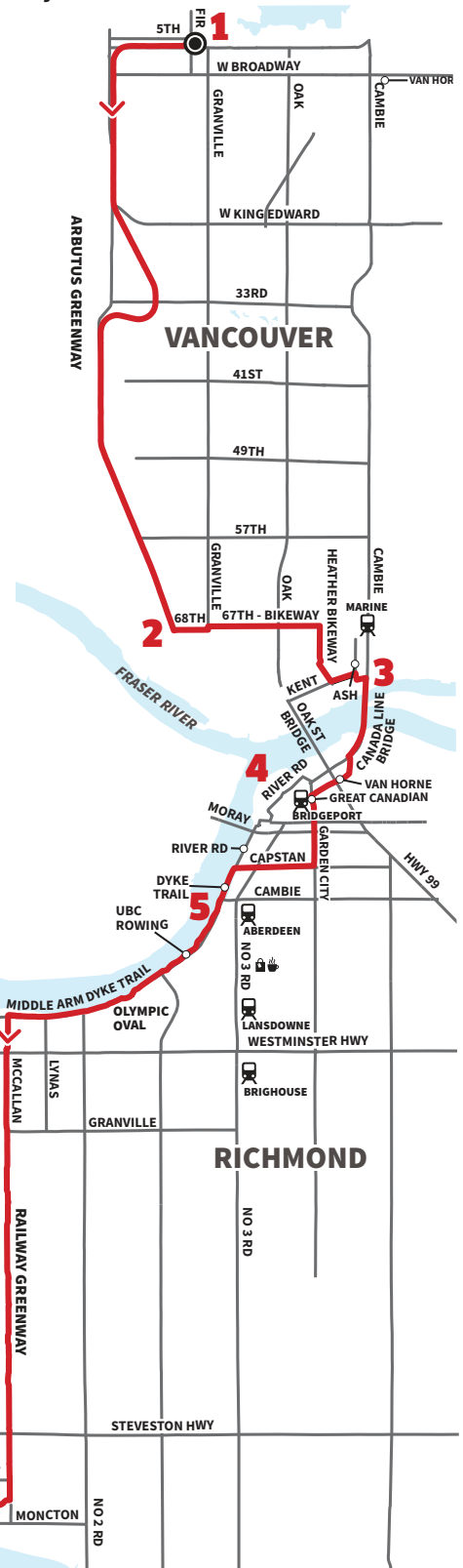


VANCOUVER • RICHMOND Paved greenways, bikeways, shared roads **22km one way • 44km return**

Ride the rails-to-trails from Vancouver to Steveston. Start on the Arbutus Greenway, ride over the Canada Line Bridge, along Middle Arm Dyke Trail then follow Railway Greenway. Visit the historic fishing village of Steveston on the Fraser River and have lunch at Fisherman's Wharf.

START at 5th Ave & Fir St - Vancouver

- 1 WEST then SOUTH** on Arbutus Greenway - 8.5km
- 2 LEFT/E** 68th follow signed 67th-Bikeway, **RIGHT/S** Heather Bikeway
- 3 LEFT/E** Kent, **RIGHT/S** Ash, cross Canada Line Bridge
- 4 SOUTH** Van Horne, **LEFT/S** Great Canadian, cross Bridgeport, **SOUTH** Garden City, **RIGHT/W** Capstan
- 5 SOUTH** on Middle Arm Dyke Trail
- 6 LEFT/S** McCallan, cross Granville, **SOUTH** on Railway Greenway for 6km, just **S** of Garry go **RIGHT** at trail with railroad sign
*visit Interurban Museum
- 7** *Explore Steveston: Fisherman's Wharf, Britannia Shipyard, return via same route or take Skytrain back from Aberdeen Station

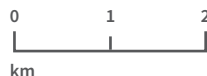
